遣明使眼中的明代城市一宁波

NingBo : A Chinese City viewed by Envoys of Muromachi Japan

宁波是15、16世纪间日本遣明使来到中国的登录口岸,同时也是他们在中国期间最主要的活动舞台。作为一个从8世纪开始便与日本产生重要关联的城市,宁波经由历史上与日本之间人员、物资、技术与文化的交流而与之结成了稳定的沟通渠道。

这种历史积淀使得明代时来到中国的日本使节们几乎毫无障碍的融入到了这个异国城市的生活中,并通过他们独特的视角和细致的描述为我们展现出一幅15、16世纪日本人眼中的宁波——这一中国江南城市的生活画卷。



Ningbo has been an important port city and kept in touch with Japan since the Tang Dynasty. In the 15th and 16th century, envoys from Muromachi Japan started their tribute mission once they arrived at Ningbo. They enjoyed their life in this city and observed it with great interest. There are many records of this city in the diaries of Japanese envoys at that time. These records show the ways in which Japanese saw and understood Chinese societies in the 15th and 16th century.
