<Tobunken/ASNET Seminar> The Changing Nature of Japan's ODA Policy towards Myanmar since 1988

日本の対ミャンマー政府開発援助—政策変容の過程について

Along with the changing domestic political situations in Myanmar in 1988, it can be seen the changes in bilateral ties especially in terms of Japan's ODA policy towards Myanmar. Again, the changing domestic political situation of Myanmar after 2010 election paved the way for the renewal of bilateral relations between two countries. The fundamental changes came in March 2011 with the inauguration of the new democratic government led by

President U Thein Sein by introducing reform measures. These changes led to improve relations with Western democratic nations and also Japan. Under these circumstances, Japanese motivation for assistance was also augmented by new rationales. Based on this background, this presentation will examine the changing nature of Japanese aid policy towards Myanmar since 1988.
